

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GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT




UNEMPLOYMENT AND UNDEREMPLOYMENT RATES


INFLATION As of January 2011

NEW AND EXISTING HOME SALES



NEW AND EXISTING HOMES SUPPLY



S&P / CASE-SHILLER HOME PRICE INDICES



RESIDENTIAL VS. COMMERCIAL PROPERTY PRICES




COMMERCIAL PROPERTY PRICE GROWTH RATES BY SECTOR

VACANCY RATES BY PROPERTY TYPE



As of December 2010




